

## SURVEY DESCRIPTION OF A .225 ACRE TRACT FOR THE

## COLUMBUS & FRANKLIN COUNTY METROPOLITAN PARK DISTRICT

Situated in Good Hope Township, Hocking County, Ohio; being part of the East half of the Southeast quarter of Section 16, Township 13, Range 18; and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8" iron pin found at the Southeast corner of a 0.50 acre tract surveyed on March 24, 1977 by Dumond-Sifford and Associates and as recorded in deed reference Volume 162, Page 598; thence South 32 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East a distance of 108.26 feet to a point in the center of County Road 116, Clear Creek Road, from which the intersection of said County Road 116 and the East line of Section 16 bears North 82 degrees 30 minutes 00 seconds East at a distance of 114.06 feet;

thence with the center of said County Road 116 South 83 degrees 05 minutes 06 seconds West a distance of 136.33 feet to a point;

thence leaving the center of said County Road 116 North 32 degrees 02 minutes 30 seconds West a distance of 50.46 feet to a 5/8" iron pin found and passing a 3/4" OD iron pipe found at a distance of 25.00 feet;

thence North 58 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East a distance of 123.51 feet to the point of beginning, containing .225 acres more or less, and subject to the public easement of County Road 116 and any other public or private easements of record.

The above .225 acre survey is intended to describe part of a tract as deeded to the Columbus & Franklin County Metropolitan Park District, deed reference Volume 160, Page 454, Hocking County Recorder's Office. This survey was based upon information obtained from tax maps, deed descriptions, previous surveys, existing monumentation, and an existing public road. The reference bearing for this survey is the South line of a March 24, 1977 .50 acre survey by Dummond-Sifford and Associates as North 58 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East. Bearings are based upon an assumed meridian and are to denote angles only. No iron pins were set by this survey. The above described property was surveyed by Larry P. Dear Mr. Underwood,

We have completed a review of the plat and computor printouts you sent us. A brief outline of our check follows.

We first ran the bearings and distances listed on your print out through our computor and matched your acreage exactly.

Next we proofed your printout with the recorded deed description to see if there were any discrepancies. We found a few and marked them on the copies enclosed. Most of the discrepancies were from rounding the distances to the nearest tenth. But the distance between points 81-82 is shown as 4064.0 feet by print out and 4067.0 feet by deed description. The closing bearing and distance shown on the print out, which was apparently forced closed, shows N 84 $^{\circ}$  09' 57" W, 1341.96 feet and the deed calls for N 84 $^{\circ}$  06' W, 1337.9 feet.


We then ran traverse using coordinates 5000.0/15000.0 and inserting those differences which we found. When we originally ran traverse, all we had to use was the deed description and those courses given. Using these coordinates we matched within one tenth of an acre of the most recent acreage calculation, and also with a 1.8' bust. This closure is still within the county's standards for error of closure. This of course still doesn't explain our original figure of 982.28 acres. It was originally run with beginning coordinates of 1000.0/1000.0. The computor has either mis-calculated because of those beginning coordinates used or it somehow just mis-calculated the acreage while still giving a closure that matches what we got using coordinates 5000.0/15000.0.

Most importantly, we do match what you now show, 1094.46 acres more or less. We might add that an acreage difference between 1090.0, as shown on deed, and 1094.46, as calculated, would not be acceptable to our survey standards if this was a newly submitted survey.
