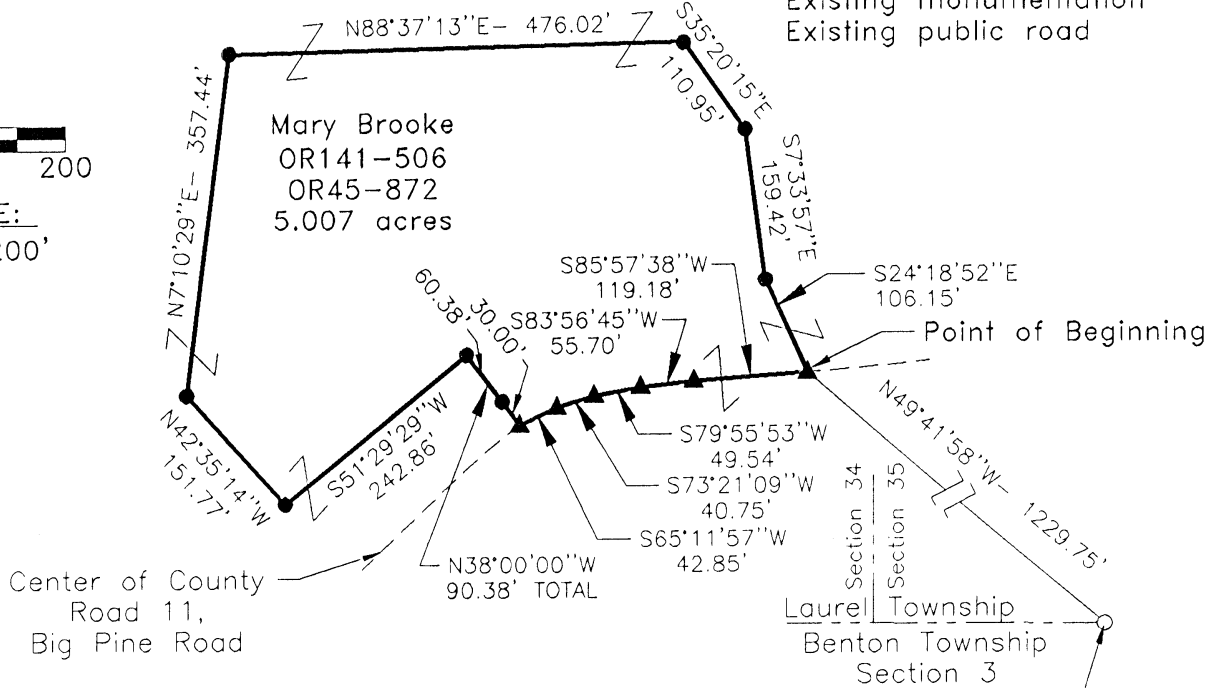
PLAT OF A REVISED 5.007 ACRE TRACT FOR CARL BROOKE
